But now that his guardianship of his brother's daughter, Theodora, has come to an end, since she was now married to the Imperial Counsellor Christopher Elephant, he has had a chance to look among his late brother's books for any writings of Olympia Morata that Celio had asked for. Among the pieces he has found and is now sending are her translation from Boccaccio. He is also sending some epitaphs on his brother.*

Ihr Hofarzt Gian Sinapius, der Universitätsprofessor Celio Curione, beides Freunde von Olympia Morato, Chilian Sinapius [nicht Kilian, sondern sein Bruder Johannes !], der mit einer Hofdame der Herzogin, Francesca Bucyronia, verheiratet war, waren sämtlich heiße Anhänger der Reformation.
